The FCSS program is designed:

- to promote, encourage and facilitate voluntarism and the use of volunteers;
- to be of a preventive nature to enhance, strengthen and stabilize family and community life;
- to improve the ability of persons to identify and act on their own social needs, to help avert family or community breakdown, or if early symptoms of social breakdown do appear, to help prevent the development of a crisis that may require major intervention or rehabilitative measures;
- to provide citizens with information on its planning and operation;
- to provide for the development of services on the basis of clearly identified social needs and effective planning; and
- to encourage cooperation and coordination with allied service agencies operating within the municipality.

In implementing this mandate, we offer the following services among others:

- **HOME SUPPORT** is a referral service for those who due to mental/physical or medical reasons are unable to do their own housekeeping. This is a subsidized program for those who qualify.
- **MEALS-ON-WHEELS** maintains and improves the nutritional health of those who are unable to prepare adequate meals for themselves.
- **SENIORS OUTREACH SERVICES** provides assistance to seniors with filling out forms, information and referrals.
- **VOLUNTEER ACTION CENTRE** The Volunteer Centre supports organizations that are dependent on volunteers. Training and resources for non-profit organizations are available. We also help volunteers find volunteer work that fits their skills, their interests, and their time. Go to [www.volunteervegreville.ca](http://www.volunteervegreville.ca) for more information.
- **COMMUNITY COUNSELLING SERVICES** short term supportive therapy. See page 28.

Individuals are required to complete all available appeals before the Ombudsman may consider investigating. The Office of the Ombudsman also assists individuals in directing complaints to the appropriate contact, department, or other complaint mechanism when the complaint is outside the Ombudsman's jurisdiction to investigate. The Ombudsman does not investigate disputes between private individuals.

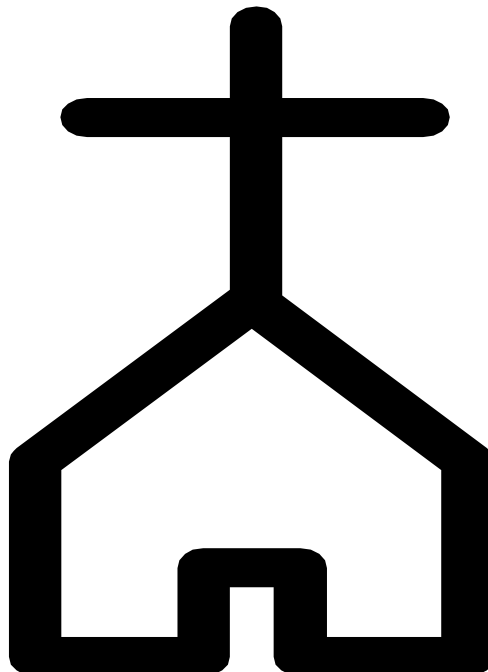

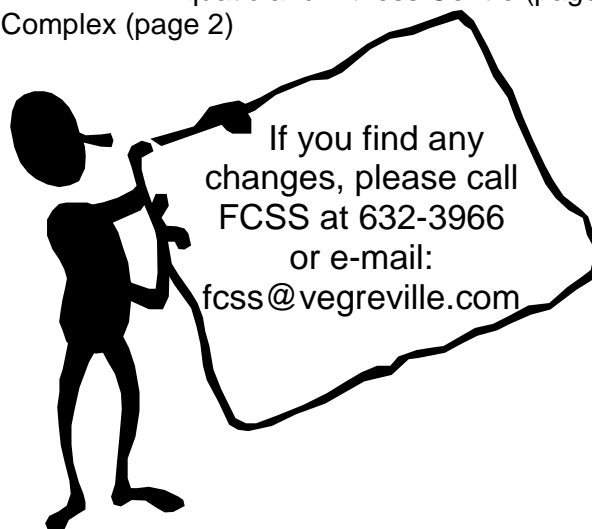

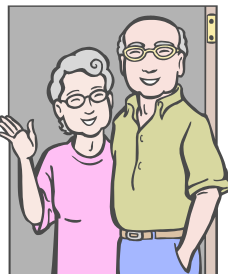

### **Public Health Nursing**

- promote health, prevent or protect against disease, injury or disability and aid clients in achieving and maintaining healthy lifestyles by adopting sound health practices
- assist communities in assessing, identifying and responding to health needs and improve health status of their populations
- achieve and maintain health through prenatal and postnatal support, breastfeeding support, disease follow up, immunization with consent

### **Home Care Services**

The Home Care Program assists individuals to improve and maintain their health, independence and quality of life. Services are provided in the home and in a variety of other community living settings.

Health Care services may include professional nursing care, physical and occupational rehabilitation therapy, wellness and prevention services, respite, personal care supports, equipment and supplies, self/guardian managed care.

### **Regional Placement Office, North**

On assessed care needs, the Regional Placement Office determines appropriate placement to continuing care centres, designated supportive housing and specialized dementia units.

### **Dental/Oral Health**

The Oral Health program promotes dental awareness through clinical, educational and school programs. Preventative clinical services such as sealants, cleanings, scaling, fluoride application, oral hygiene instruction and nutrition counselling are offered to 3 – 15 year olds with no dental insurance. There is a small fee for clinical services.

### **Environmental Health**

Public Health Inspectors work as a part of a multi-disciplinary health team which helps reduce the incidence of communicable disease and health hazards, provides consultative and educational services and identifies hazards in residential, recreational, commercial, social and industrial premises. Some of the services provided include teaching safe food courses, inspection of rental properties, water analysis, communicable disease follow-up and education to the public on a variety of topics.

### **Sexual Health Education**

Sexual Health Consultants provide counselling, information, consultations and group presentations on a variety of topics related to sexuality such as sexually transmitted diseases, birth control, women's and men's reproductive health, relationships, sexual development, communication, sexual orientation, sexual harassment, dating violence, pregnancy options counselling and pre and post abortion counselling is also available.

### **Early Intervention**

Early Intervention services are provided to families of children 0 to 3 ½ years of age. Children must be developmentally delayed or be "at risk" for delay due to biological circumstances. Services are provided to families in the child's home environment.

### **Health Promotion**

Health Promotion is defined as a “process of enabling people to increase control over and to improve their health”. Empowering people to improve their health and exploring factors influencing health (i.e.; determinants of health) are the main guideposts of this process. The determinants of health include: social support, education, employment and working conditions, health child development, personal health practices and coping skills, human biology, health services, culture and spirituality.

### **Audiology**

Audiologists provide diagnostic and rehabilitative services to people of all ages with hearing disorders. Audiological services maximize functional ability and promote quality of life and independence.

### **Occupational Therapy**

Community Health Services provides occupational therapy through the Community Rehabilitation Program. Qualified Therapists can provide assessment, treatment, consultation and referral.

### **Physical Therapy**

Community Health Services provides physical therapy through the Community Rehabilitation Program. Qualified Therapists can provide assessment, treatment, consultation and referral.
