On Thursday, April 30th the Province of Alberta announced the Alberta COVID-19 Relaunch Strategy, a plan that puts safety first, while gradually reopening businesses and activities to the public, and getting people back to work. The Town of Vegreville has responded to the Province's efforts, by developing a Town of Vegreville COVID-19 Relaunch Plan for re-opening public facilities and services.

Much like the Provincial Relaunch Strategy, the Town's Plan places the health and safety of our residents and staff as our top priority, while gradually re-opening municipal facilities and services that our residents and businesses so eagerly anticipate.

The Town of Vegreville will wait for further direction from the Province before releasing Stage 2 of our Relaunch Plan. The Town will pay particular attention to the progression of the Province's Relaunch and will base subsequent stages of our re-opening on the Government of Alberta's Relaunch progress and success.

STAGE 1

EFFECTIVE MAY 19, 2020

Town Offices

- The number of customers are restricted within each office. Chairs are placed two meters apart outside of each office to meet physical distancing requirements for those waiting to enter.
- The main door to each office will remain open to avoid having to sanitize door knobs after each visitor.
- Hand sanitizer is available for customers to use in each office.
- Markings are placed on the floor as visual indications for physical distancing.
- Touch points such as keypads for debit machines and countertops will be sanitized between each use.
- Offices are open Monday to Friday, 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM, closed between 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM.
- Receipts are the only item that will be provided to customers, all other resources and material must be accessed through our website.
- There will be no washroom available for public use.

Emergency Services Building

Public access is by appointment only, and appointments will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Outdoor Ice Rink

The Outdoor Ice Rink is open. A maximum of 50 people are permitted to use the space at a time. All users must maintain physical distancing at all times. NO organized public games or league play is permitted at this time.

Vegreville Materials Recovery Facility (VMRF)

The VMRF remains closed to the public. However, residents can drop items off at the facility by following the directions posted onsite.

Skate Park

The Skate Park is open. A maximum of 50 people are permitted to use the space at a time. All users must maintain physical distancing at all times.

As per the Government of Alberta's COVID-19 Relaunch Strategy and the Town's Municipal COVID- 19 Relaunch Plan the following Town facilities will remain closed until further notice:

Dog Off-Leash Area (DOLA)

The DOLA remains open. A maximum of 50 people are permitted to be in the space at a time. All users must maintain physical distancing at all times. Those who use the DOLA are urged to practice good hygiene by washing their hands following their visit and disinfecting personal equipment.

Outdoor Sports Areas

Basketball Courts, Baseball Diamonds and Soccer Fields are open. A maximum of 50 people are permitted to use the space at a time. NO organized public games or league play is permitted at this time. We strongly recommend that users sanitize their equipment after each use.

Landfill

The Landfill remains open. However, measures are in place to restrict contact between staff and customers.

Tennis Courts

The Tennis Courts are open. A maximum of 4 people are permitted to be in the space at a time. All users must maintain physical distancing at all times. NO organized public games or league play is permitted at this time. Equipment such as balls and tennis rackets will not be provided, and we strongly recommend that court-users sanitize their equipment after each use.
