Highway 16A Construction

At 67th Street and Range Road 144, in the Town of Vegreville

Overview

Alberta Transportation will begin construction mid August 2020, on two intersections on Highway 16A within the Town of Vegreville. The project will include milling, paving and line painting at the intersections of Highway 16A and 67th Street, as well as Highway 16A and Range Road 144. Included as part of this project is 19 km of paving on Highway 857, south of Highway 16.

Project Details

Work will include milling and paving of approximately 500 m at the intersection of Highway 16A and 67th St, and paving approximately of 400 m at the intersection of Highway 16A and Range Road 144. Additional work will include line painting and the installation of cross walks.

Work at the intersections is anticipated to begin mid to late August and will take approximately two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

This work is in conjunction with 19 km of paving on Highway 857, south of Highway 16, which may affect scheduling.

Traffic Impacts

As with any construction project, travelers may experience speed reductions, lane closures and minor delays. Signage with additional information on construction timing will be posted on site a week before construction begins. No detours are anticipated. A traffic accommodation strategy is also in place to mitigate the impacts to travelers. This includes additional signage, delineation, and if required, illumination.
